

HomeWorld Helpers Grant – terms and conditions

Purpose of document: this document outlines the terms, conditions, and responsibilities in relation to the provision of funding from the HomeWorld Helpers Grant.

Definitions

1. In these conditions.

“HomeWorld” refers to HomeWorld Pty Ltd (ABN 55 007 924 674)

“CNSW” refers to the New South Wales Cricket Association, known as Cricket NSW

Background:

The HomeWorld Helpers Grant exists to support cricket clubs across the Thunder Nation territory to based help grow the game at a grassroots level. With the generous support of Sydney Thunder partner, HomeWorld, clubs will be able to apply for a grant provided it meets the eligibility criteria below The CNSW Foundation will also be contributing funds at a “dollar-match” value to increase the scale of the program, with a total fund of \$10,000 available for the 2021-22 season.

Eligibility Criteria:

For an application to be deemed eligible, the following criteria must be met:

- Must be a cricket club and registered to a CNSW affiliated Association or be a CNSW affiliated Association
- Must participate in or host a Woolworths Cricket Blast Program
- Field at least one junior team
- Have adopted and endorsed the Australian Cricket Safeguarding Children and Young people framework
- Must benefit junior cricketers or the whole of club. Applications focused on senior cricketers will not be considered
- Projects must aim to “enhance lives through cricket”

Warranties and Undertakings:

By submitting an application, the club warrants and agrees to the following;

- Everything in the application is true and correct as at the date of application
- The club will comply with all laws and regulations in relation to your application
- You will not bring into disrepute Sydney Thunder, HomeWorld or the HomeWorld Helpers Grant at any time
- Any and all correspondence between Sydney Thunder and the club is confidential and will not be shared with any persons outside of the club in which the application is made on behalf of
- That the nominated bank details provided are in the control of the cricket club
- That the representative undertaking the application is a nominated delegate or committee member of the club
- The club will only use the grant for what is stated in your application and
- You will provide evidence of how the grant was used, if requested by Sydney Thunder.

Process:

1. Applications will open at 9:00am 1st September 2021 and close at 5:00pm 15th September 2021 and will be accessible via the grants portal (link)
2. Applications will be assessed by the Sydney Thunder grants panel
3. Applications must be made by an authorized member of the applying club and be submitted via the grant's portal
4. Once submitted, no changes can be made to the application, except that, an application can be withdrawn via communication with the Sydney Thunder contact
5. Incomplete applications are deemed invalid and will not be considered
6. Only one grant application can be submitted per club, in the case of more than one application being submitted the first application will be considered
7. The amount of funds allocated to each club will be at the discretion of Sydney Thunder
8. Sydney Thunder does not warrant or guarantee that grants to successful clubs will be of equal value
9. Grant funding decisions are final, and appeals will not be considered
10. Sydney Thunder will notify successful applicants as soon as reasonably possible but before 1st October 2021 5:00pm

Funding:

- Cricket NSW will manage the payment of grants to all successful applicants
- If you receive notice from Sydney Thunder that your grant application has been successful, payment will be made to your nominated club bank account within 30 days of being notified of your successful application

Media:

In submitting the application, you consent, on behalf of your club and its members, to Sydney Thunder and HomeWorld, using your Club's name, likeness, image, and or voice in the event you are successful (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting the HomeWorld Helpers grant

You will not make any public announcement, press release, launch, promotion or advertisement about your application, the grant, Sydney Thunder or HomeWorld without the written consent of Sydney Thunder or HomeWorld which may be withheld at the discretion of Sydney Thunder and HomeWorld.

Indemnity and Limitation of Liability:

In submitting the application, you agree that the club will not make any claim against Sydney Thunder and/or HomeWorld in relation to the application by your club, the grant process or any grant to the club.
